

### Terms and Conditions 2022

Under the “Think Local First This Christmas” initiative, Maranoa Regional Council (MRC), in partnership with Roma Commerce & Tourism (RCAT), Booringa Action Group (BAG), Surat & District Development Association (SDDA), local businesses and the community, are coordinating a shop local campaign across the Maranoa, in the lead up to Christmas.

The purpose of the campaign is to encourage residents to purchase Christmas gifts from local retailers and support local businesses this Christmas, as opposed to shopping online or in larger centres.

The 2022 shop local campaign consists of five (5) x Local Area competitions as part of a regional initiative.

The five (5) Local Area competitions comprise the following areas:

- Roma (& surrounds)
- Booringa (Mitchell & surrounds)
- Bungil (Injune & surrounds)
- Warroo (Surat & surrounds)
- Bendemere (Wallumbilla/Yuleba & surrounds)

In conjunction with the Local Area competitions, a regional draw will also take place.

By entering the competition, entrants agree to the following Terms & Conditions.

#### **Prizes**

Each local competition consists of prizes donated by respective local businesses. Therefore, the prize pool and applicable prize conditions for each Local Area competition vary, according to donations received. Prizes may consist of vouchers and/or physical items.

Donated prizes will be drawn on the following dates at the locations listed below:

- Roma – 1 December 2022 at the Maranoa Christmas Street Party
- Booringa – 2 December 2022 at the Rotary & BAG Christmas in the Park
- Bungil - 11 December 2022 at the Injune Community Carols
- Warroo – 3 December 2022 at the Surat Ambulance Christmas Party
- Bendemere – 3 December 2022 at the Wallumbilla Christmas Party

The Regional draw will take place on 1 December 2022 at the Maranoa Christmas Street Party.

Prizes are not transferrable for cash and are only redeemable as per conditions stated by the respective business donating the prize. This includes timeframes and conditions for which the prizes must be collected. Prizes do not include delivery.

### Entry

To enter the competition, a single minimum purchase of \$10 is required at participating businesses in the Maranoa Region.

Each entry will go into the Local Area draw respective of where the purchase was made i.e., if a minimum purchase of \$10 is made at a participating store in the Mitchell area, the entry will go into the Booringa (Mitchell & Surrounds) Local Area draw.

Entries from outside the respective Local Area will not be accepted. i.e., an entry resulting from a minimum \$10 purchase at a participating Roma business cannot be entered into the Warroo (Surat & Surrounds) or any other Local Area competition, other than the Roma & Surrounds Local Area draw.

Every entry in any of the five (5) Local area competitions is automatically entered into the Regional Draw for a chance to win the regional prize.

There is no limit to the number of times an entrant can enter the competition, however **ONLY ONE ENTRY IS VALID FOR EACH TRANSACTION OVER \$10.**

The entrant must complete the paper ticket available at participating businesses and place it into an approved collection box. All fields on the entry form must be completed for the entry to be valid and accepted.

Entries will not be accepted via phone or email.

The competition opens on Tuesday, 1 November 2022.

Entries for each local draw will close:

- Roma – 7pm, 1 December 2022
- Booringa – 5pm, 1 December 2022
- Bungil - 4pm, 9 December 2022
- Warroo – 5pm, 2 December 2022
- Bendemere – 5pm, 2 December 2022

After this time, no further entries to the competition will be accepted.

Winners of the Booringa Local Area draw will be required to be present at the time of draw (2 December 2022). Winners of all other prizes do not need to be present at the time of the draw.

If the winner is not present at the time of the draw (for the Roma, Warroo, Bendemere, Bungil & Regional draws only) they will be contacted via phone or email to arrange collection of the prize.

If the winners are unable to be contacted within 14 days following the draw, a new winner will be drawn and notified.

Winners are responsible for the collection of the prize. Delivery is not included.

Winners agree to the usage of their name and image in any publicity material.

Entrants under the age of 18 must have parent/guardian consent to enter and a parent/guardian must be present to collect the prize.

By entering this competition, the entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

### **Businesses**

Businesses across the Maranoa region are eligible to participate in the competition. Upon request, they will be supplied with signage and paper tickets to allow their customers to enter. There is no cost to businesses to participate.

All market stallholders present at the Maranoa Christmas Street Party are eligible to participate in the competition.

By participating in this competition, the business is indicating its agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
