

Dear Dog Owner,

You may not be aware, but your dog is currently causing a noise nuisance in the neighbourhood by barking excessively.

Maranoa Regional Council suggests I contact you as the first step, to express my concern and allow you the opportunity to rectify the situation without referring the matter to Council for assistance.

Attached is some information provided by Council that could help you identify why your dog may be barking excessively and provide some possible solutions.
